This fantastic and varied collection, which he inherited from his Italian ancestors and then added to through his own efforts, remains hugely renowned to this day.

Hunting and fishing are incredibly popular in the area, and the autumn months offer particularly favourable conditions for these activities. Plus, gastronomes are certain to appreciate the inventiveness and mastery with which fish and game specialities are prepared in many of the region's restaurants.

The region offers many leisure opportunities for active visitors, including cycling, horseback riding, and motor plane sightseeing and hot air balloon flights. All this can be found near the château, as well as Gold Resort Konopište, one of the most well-known golf resorts in the Czech Republic. It boasts two 18-hole master courses, excellent training facilities for beginners, a course open to the public, restaurants and accommodation. Konopište is a great starting point for trips



across the region, while the pleasant town of Benešov is not far away, located only about 30 minutes from Prague.
